AUDITIONS

Auditions will be held **on Tuesday 14 February 2023** at the Senior School, 2 Manresa Court, Athelstone. The Auditioning Panel will consist of the Head of Music and one other member of Music Department staff. The audition will allow for up to ten minutes of performed music, plus a brief sight-reading and aural test. Applicants may audition on more than one instrument, but within the total given time frame of ten minutes. Applicants are encouraged to bring their own accompanist, and a venue for 'warming up' will be provided. We suggest that applicants select pieces contrasting in style to demonstrate technique and musicianship. The Audition Panel will recommend students demonstrating musical potential, performance skill, and a strong commitment to music.

OUR EXPECTATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

The following points represent the expectations of the Music Department for Scholarship recipients:

- Whilst it is not a condition for Music Scholarship recipients to undertake a course of study in music at senior level (Year 12) at the College, it is encouraged. It is expected, however, that recipients of Music Scholarships will study music in Year 7 to Year 11.
- Scholarship recipients will be students with a high level of accomplishment on their chosen instrument. They will:
 - Endeavour to excel in all areas of music within the College through their participation in at least two instrumental/vocal ensembles at the College through to Year 12.
 - Assume the seriousness of commitment to rehearsal schedules, personal practice routines, and the endeavour
 of excellence.
 - Maintain a high level of application and performance through a continued study of their instrument.
 - Involve themselves in the broader life of music at the College which may include musical participation in liturgies.
- An annual review of the student's progress and contribution will be made. If progress is not satisfactory, the terms
 of the scholarship may need to be reassessed.
- It is expected that scholarship recipients will remain at the College for the duration of their scholarship. Departure from the College during the term of the scholarship, unless the departure is at the request of the College or mutually agreed to between College and parents, may require reimbursement to the College of the value of the scholarship.
