

## College Bus Services



Saint Ignatius' College is proud to offer exclusive bus services to Ignatian families, providing safe and convenient student transport to and from our Junior School and Senior School campuses before and after school.

#### Campus Link Bus Service

Our morning and afternoon Campus Link bus service is a part of our commitment to safety, accessibility, and convenience for our families.

The Campus Link provides convenient and supervised student transfers between our Norwood and Athelstone campuses. Some Campus Link bus trips make a number of stops along the route for students to board and disembark the bus. This offers convenience to families by providing drop-off and pick-up locations that are much closer to their home.

This bus service is enhanced by the BusMinder App. This free app notifies parents through their mobile phone when their child has boarded the bus and allows them to track the bus' journey, providing its real-time location and accurate timing of each stop.

All Campus Link bus trips are supervised by a staff member from the College.

All students who access the Campus Link bus service are required to register their seat in advance.




#### Norwood to Athelstone






## Athelstone to Norwood

#### JS Northern Connector

As part of our dedication to safety, accessibility, and convenience, we also offer the Junior School Northern Connector bus service for Junior School families each morning and afternoon.

The bespoke JS Northern Connector services families living north of the Junior School. Its route was designed based on community demand. The bus makes a number of stops along the route for students to board and disembark the bus in locations close to their homes.

This bus service is enhanced by the BusMinder App. This free app notifies parents through their mobile phone when their child has boarded the bus and allows them to track the bus' journey, providing its real-time location and accurate timing of each stop.


JS Northern Connector bus trips are provided by Des's Minibus.

#### Afternoon Route


In the afternoon, the JS Northern Connector departs from the Junior School and travels to Adelaide City Car Park on Hilltop Drive, Oakden.

# How does the BusMinder App work?

- All families who access our Campus Link or JS Northern Connector bus services need to register their seat in advance through jsadmin@ignatius.sa.edu.au (Junior School) or receptionsenior@ignatius.sa.edu.au (Senior School)
- 2. In the email parents will need to provide the students name and class and their written consent for the College to forward their email address to a third-party provider (BusMinder).
- From here, support will be provided to access the free BusMinder App in order to use our services.
- Parents will be provided with a Bus Minder fob at the Junior School. At the Senior School, student ID cards will be connected to BusMinder by Front Office staff.
- 5. Students will use their fob/student ID card to 'tap-on' upon boarding the bus. This then notifies their parents via their designated mobile phone that their child is on the bus. Through the app parents can see the real time location and movement of the bus for accurate timing of each stop.

# Additional Adelaide Metro Bus Services

## The College is well serviced by standard Adelaide Metro bus routes.

A comprehensive network of buses services the Senior School at Athelstone which is located only seven minutes from the Paradise Interchange and 15 minutes from Norwood. Students boarding in the city are carried along the O-Bahn to the Paradise Interchange in a matter of minutes.
