



Music Scholarships For Students Entering Year 7 in 2027 Application Information

Saint Ignatius' College Music Scholarships are open to instrumentalists and vocalists and will be awarded to students, through audition, who display outstanding musical ability and a sound academic record. The ability to play more than one instrument is desirable. Applicants may have a classical, contemporary, or jazz background in music. A minimum of two years' experience on their instrument or an AMEB equivalent of Grade 4 is required.

APPLICATION

Please complete and return the application form, payment form (for \$50.00) and attach the following support material:

- Letter of recommendation from applicant's current instrumental/vocal teacher.
- List of AMEB, TRINITY, SUZUKI certificates and/or awards (refer to Page 2).
- Copy of applicant's most recent school report.
- A letter, written by the applicant in their own words, expressing why they wish to attend the College and what excites them about music.
- Any other information deemed necessary.
- Saint Ignatius' College Music Scholarships are not available to overseas students.

AUDITIONS

- Auditions will be held on **Tuesday 10 February 2026** at the Senior School, 2 Manresa Court, Athelstone.
- The auditioning panel will consist of the Leader of Learning for Music, the Program Leader of Co-curricular Music and a member of the Pastoral Team.
- The audition will allow for up to ten minutes of performed music, plus a brief sight-reading and aural test.
- Applicants may audition on more than one instrument, but within the total given time frame of ten minutes.
- Applicants are encouraged to bring their own piano accompanist as there will not be one provided.
- A warm-up room will be made available to each applicant prior to their audition.
- Applicants should prepare pieces that are contrasting in style and genre, demonstrating technique and musicianship.
- The Audition Panel will recommend students demonstrating musical potential, performance skill, and a strong commitment to music.

OUR EXPECTATIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

The following points represent the expectations of the Music Department for Scholarship recipients:

- Recipients of a Music Scholarship are expected to study music as a timetabled curriculum subject up to, and including, Year 11. Whilst it is not a condition of a scholarship, recipients are strongly encouraged to continue the study of music through to Year 12.
- Recipients of a Music Scholarship are expected to participate in at least two Co-curricular Music ensembles, which includes rehearsal, workshop and performance, up to, and including, Year 12.
- Music Scholarship students will be students with a high level of accomplishment on their chosen instrument. They will:
 - Endeavour to excel in all areas of music within the College.
 - Maintain a high level of application and performance through a continued study of their instrument(s).
 - Involve themselves in the broader life of music at the College which could include participation in music at liturgies, assisting with the running of performances and assuming a leadership role within the department.
- An annual review of the students' progress and contribution will be made. If progress is not satisfactory, the terms of the scholarship may need to be reassessed.
- It is expected that scholarship recipients will remain at the College for the duration of their scholarship. Departure from the College during the term of the scholarship, unless the departure is at the request of the College or mutually agreed to between College and parents, may require reimbursement to the College of the value of the scholarship.
