INTERCOL

The annual Intercollegiate sporting competition aims to forge friendship and camaraderie between Saint Ignatius' College and Mercedes College. Since the first Intercol in 2005, the competition has been both a highlight of and a wonderful conclusion to the winter sports season for staff and students. Although the competition between students of both Colleges is fierce, there is an overall positive atmosphere throughout the Intercol. As such, during, before and after all matches, students from both Colleges are expected to present and conduct themselves in an exemplary manner. Senior students from both schools compete for a total of 21 shields across the co-curricular activities of Basketball, Chess, Cross Country, Debating, Football, Hockey, Netball, Soccer and Table Tennis. While middle school students don't compete for a shield, they do compete on the day, thus involving all year levels from both Colleges. After the final match of the competition, the overall 'Ignatius-Mercedes' shield is presented to the school that won the most shields over the course of the competition.

INTERCOL RULES OF COMPETITION

In general, team selection should mirror the respective school's sport policy. However, when discrepancies appear, in order to ensure a level playing field, the following should apply:


- Usual team compositions should be fielded unless injury, illness or some other issue causes player shortages.
- The spirit of the day suggests that players should not be promoted on the day to provide an artificial team standard. If there is a good player who has played Year 8, 9 or 10 all year then they should continue to play for their respective Year 8, 9 or 10 team.
- Specifically, where a school does not enter a regular Saturday Open A competition, (for example, their Open Knockout team), the guideline for selection should revert to that school's best possible team being fielded in order of playing merit.
- Teams should not be "stacked" on the day. The spirit of the day suggests that the team playing is the same as that which has represented the school from week-to-week or in the KO competition. This preserves the opportunities afforded to players who have made a commitment to their team to be involved in that same team during the Intercollegiate.

A player may play in more than one sport (e.g. AFL, soccer and basketball) but cannot play in two teams of the same sport (e.g. Open B and Open C basketball). If a player does play two games of the same sport on the day, the game will be played out, but the result will be a forfeit against the College that breached the rule. If there are situations that arise during the Carnival, they are to be dealt with by the Directors of Sport at each College, not the coaches or managers of teams.
