## *Campus Link Bus Service*

Our morning and afternoon Campus Link bus service is a part of our commitment to safety, accessibility, and convenience for our families.

Some Campus Link bus trips make a number of stops along the route for students to board and disembark the bus. This offers convenience to families by providing drop-off and pick-up locations that are much closer to their home.

This bus service is enhanced by the BusMinder App. This free app notifies parents through their mobile phone when their child has boarded the bus and allows them to track the bus' journey, providing its real-time location and accurate timing of each stop.

Campus Link bus trips are supervised by a staff member from the College (apart from one service for Senior School students only).

All students who access the Campus Link bus service are required to **register their seat in advance** through the Junior School Front Office by emailing [jsadmin@ignatius.sa.edu.au](mailto:jsadmin@ignatius.sa.edu.au) After registering, support will be provided to access the Bus Minder App.

## Athelstone to Norwood

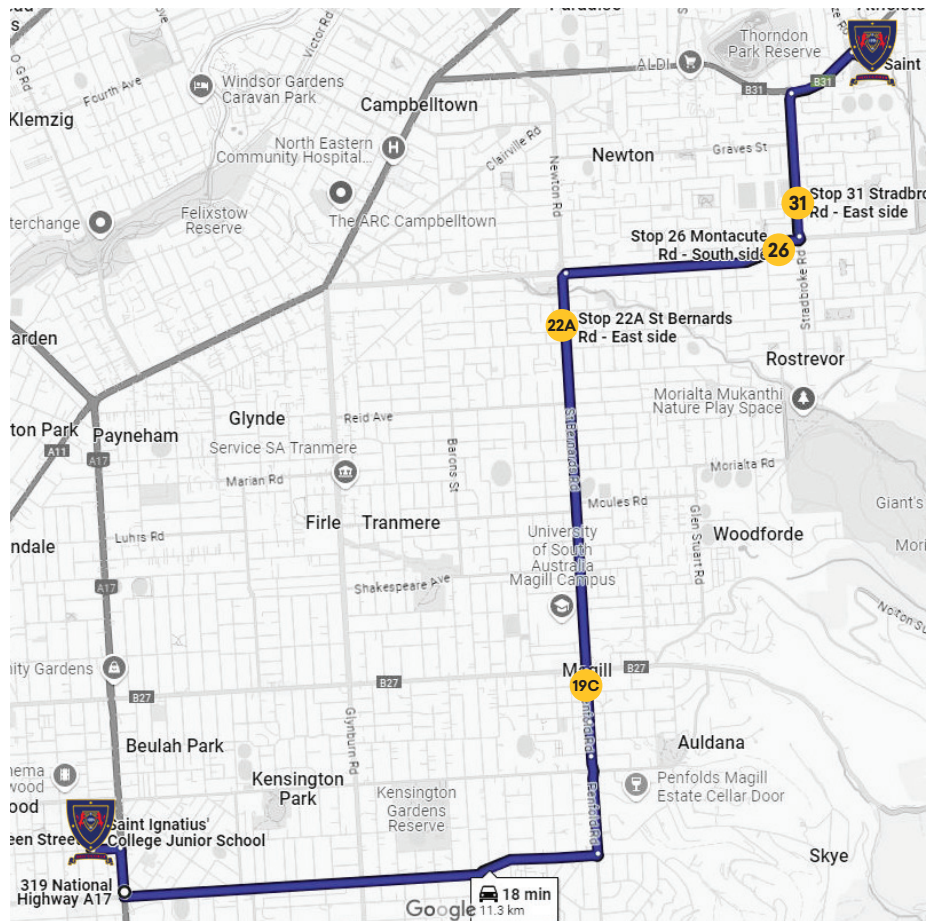

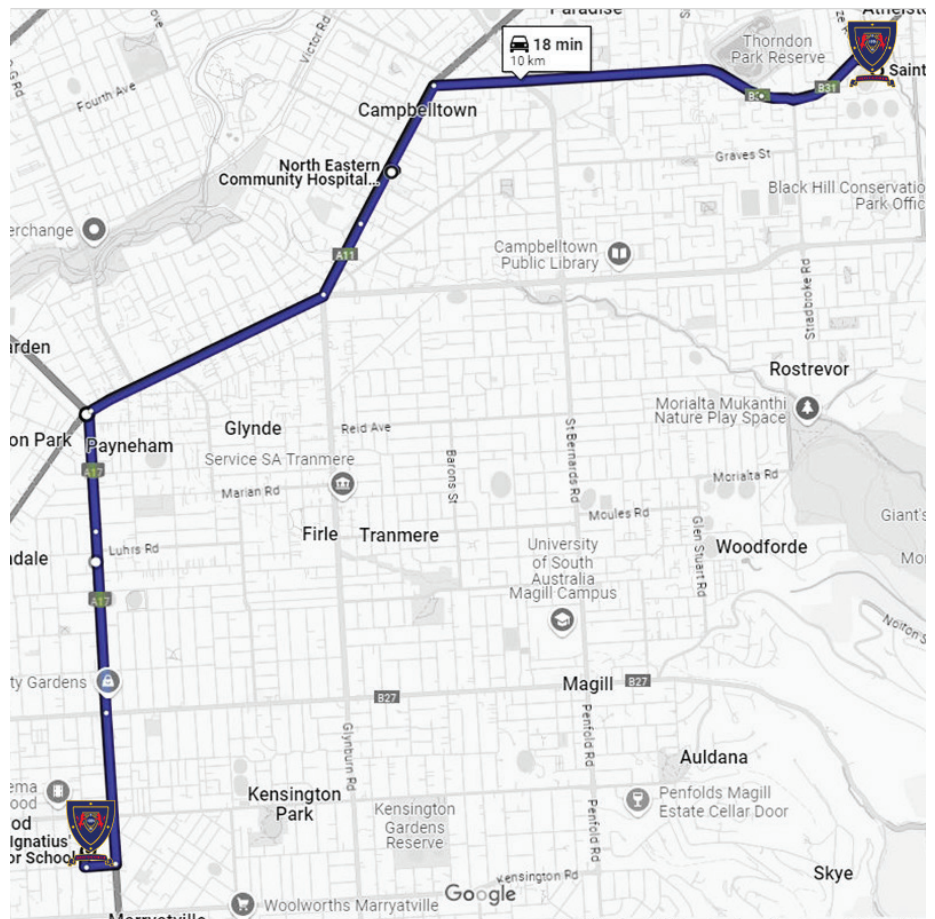
**Norwood to Athelstone**

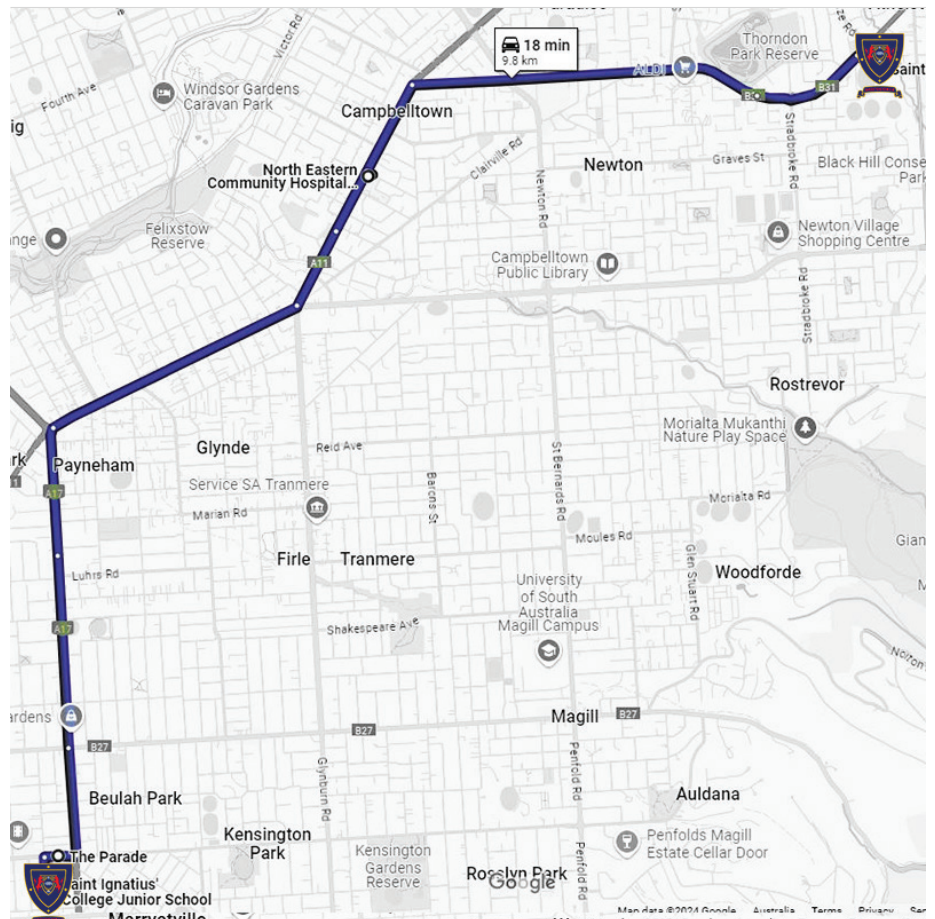
## Athelstone to Norwood

**Departs** Senior School, Gorge Rd, Lower North East Rd, Payneham Rd, Portrush Road, The Parade, Queen St, Junior School arriving approx 4:25pm







## How does the Bus Minder App work?

1. All students who access our Campus Link bus service need to register their seat with the College in advance through [jsadmin@ignatius.sa.edu.au](mailto:jsadmin@ignatius.sa.edu.au)
2. From here, support will be provided to access the free Bus Minder App in order to ride our services.
3. Parents will be provided with a Bus Minder fob.
4. Fobs must be activated by the parents through the free Bus Minder App before children can use this service. Students will use their fob to 'tap-on' upon boarding the bus. This then notifies their parents via their designated mobile phone that their child is on the bus. Through the app parents can see the real time location and movement of the bus for accurate timing of each stop.

## Additional Adelaide Metro Bus Services

The Junior School, located at Norwood, is well serviced by standard Adelaide Metro bus routes.

A comprehensive network of buses services the Senior School at Athelstone which is located only seven minutes from the Paradise Interchange and fifteen minutes from Norwood.

Students boarding in the city are carried along the O-Bahn to the Paradise Interchange in a matter of minutes.
